How Many Dogs or Cats can I have on my Residential Property?

In most residential zoning districts you can have dogs and cats as domestic pets only. The number allowed is limited to three (3) or fewer animals four (4) months of age or older.




Can I have Large Animals on Residential Property?

No. Livestock is only allowed in the Agricultural Zone Districts. However, there are some exceptions to this requirement in certain zoning districts. Please contact our Zoning Section for these exceptions and what these districts are. For this and additional information call (559) 600-4540.



Are Pigs Allowed in Residential Areas?

No. Swine are not allowed in any of the Residential Zone districts and are limited to the County's Exclusive Agricultural (AE) Districts subject to certain restrictions.



Are Chickens Allowed in Residential Areas?

No. Chickens are not allowed within the R-1, R-1-B and the R-1-C Residential Zone Districts. Chickens are allowed in the R-1-A and Rural and Exclusive Agricultural Districts subject to certain restrictions.
